Consumer / driver / owner VERY lucky accident not worse, as fatal head injuries or entire body through windshield would have been result.

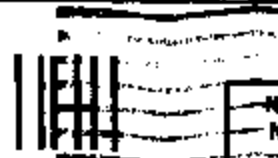
