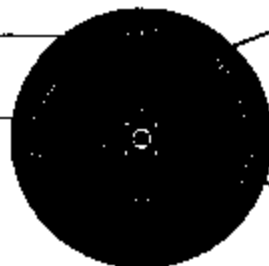

While there was no accident or injury to people, tie failure at this low milage is not acceptable (9,233miles.) I am the only driver of this vehicle and the vehicle/tires were not subject to abuse. It is a good thing I do check the condition of the car before I start to drive. I noticed the front left tire was low on air and proceed to my local station (1 mile away) to add air (32 lbs per tire) according to manufacture recommendations. I had my local tire company call Michelin and the adjuster denied the claim over the phone without even looking at the tire!
