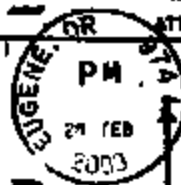

EVEN WITH THE ELECTRIC SEATS ADJUSTED FULLY DOWNWARD IT DOES NOT CORRECT THIS PROBLEM. A 22" BLADE DOES CORRECT THE PROBLEM WHICH IS ALSO STANDARD ON THE F-250 AND F-350 PICKUPS
