WE have had this SUV for a year and have taken it back to the Dealership numerous times for a problem with the steering. It is very touchy and we feel unsafe to drive it. WE have spoken with GM and they refuse to do anything about it. Bay Chevrolet has admitted that the 2 door SUV steering is very sensitive but tells us that it is a characteristic of the short wheel base. We drove a 4 door and did not find it to be sensitive to the touch of the steering wheel. Continue on back.

You have to fight the wheel to keep it on the road straight. We feel that it is unsafe to be on the road and needs to be taken off the road. We will never own another two door vehicle.

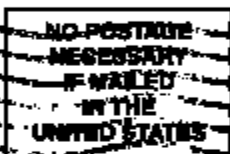
