Dash board lights actually flickered while driving. There has been no consistency to this, Dodge is aware of the problem + has put out a Technical Service Bulletin in Dec. 01. They have a fix for the problem at the cost of the consumers. But I feel that with the lights flickering during night driving that becomes a safety hazard. This has occurred at speeds from 10mph - 55mph.
