In November 2002 While traveling on the off Ramp from Interstate Route 95, to Southbound Route 5, in Prince George's County MD 1995 NISSAN MAXIMA, encountered a bumpy Road Surface, and the Rear end Swinged Around Incontrollably, this causing my car to strike the Guard Rail, This was similar to severe uncontrol situation that I experienced, the uneven pavement on the Maryland's Chesapeake Bay Bridge caused the same rear end movement all at low speeds, in April of 2003 I believed that the Maryland State Highway Administration made some repairs to the bad surface on the Ramp where I had my collision. I visited the Nissan dealer in Silver Springs Maryland, about the cost to replace the rear end in my car they informed me only about a specific bolt that's new to the replace parts for the rear end. 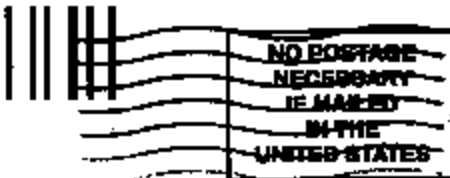
