To whom it may concern, at the office of defect and investigation.

I have already mailed a questionnaire to U.S.DOT with an explanation of what took place with my 2000 Demon Challenger travel trailer. I am going to send some photos of the trailer that were taken when the trailer was brought in for an estimate to repair the damages. The support strap is clearly visible and was on top of the fresh water tank. If you look closely at the end of the straps, the white fasteners are intact to hold the strap in place. If the strap was under the tank, it would not have fallen out of the trailer. The only thing that was holding the tank in place was a piece of 1 X 3 wood with 2 in. staples and an overcover made of 1/4 inch plastic sheeting.
