we heard a thump from the rear and pulled over to the shoulder. Found some tread had come off a tire on the right wheel. My wife, Emily Parker noticed smoke coming from the engine compartment. I got the fire extinguisher, opened the hood and put out the flames I could see, then went back in to open the inside cover. More flames lit + I used up the extinguisher. We got our two dogs and walked away from the vehicle to call 9-1-1. Officer arrived quickly, the RV in full flames. No injuries, but all contents and the vehicle assumed lost.
