When braking on icy conditions this vehicle applies brakes to the front wheels only when under 5mph. The rear wheels will continue to turn as the front wheels are locked up. This is by design and is present on all Toyota models I have tested. read back.

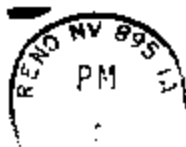
I have tested 5 different models 2001 to 2004 and all have the same malfunction.
