Narrative Description of Incident(s), Failure(s), Crash(es), and Injury(ies)

Vehicle stalls on coming to a stop. It will run, but it will not idle. You can keep the engine going with the throttle. It has done this 4 times between 2500 and 4000 miles. Turning the ignition off and on again and restarting cures the problem until the next time. After the 3rd time I took the bike to my dealer in Greenvale Hill NJ. They could find nothing wrong.

The bike starts and runs perfectly normally. It gets normal gas mileage. But it has refused to idle on coming to a stop 4 times. When the bike stalls, there is a strong smell of gas.

I feel this is dangerous if it happens in traffic because you can't move the bike right away. An impatient motorist could hit you.
