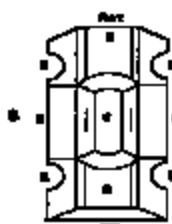

When I pulled over we could see fire coming from the bottom of the truck and we ran to the back of the vehicle AND a state trooper was there to give us further instructions.

A. NOPE, IT JUST STARTED SMOKING. [REDACTED]
