I had the old fuel pump replaced by a Nissan dealer and received the old pump back. The actual pump still works but the electrical connector on the pump wiring harness is burned. This wiring harness is located inside the fuel tank. I have the old part available for inspection.

This is twice in 2 months this vehicle has stopped running due to electrical problem with the fuel pump inside the gas tank.

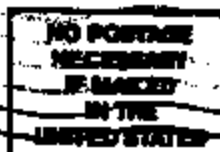
