All four rear tires, (DOT CSM 0304) were bad.

Causing Drivers Rear W/ bearing to fail which tore up Spindal. Had Hubs, bearings, Spindal & brakes replaced. Bought all new tires because Down South Cooper Dealers had no listing for these tires.

1976 Chevy had only 8900 miles on truck.
