WHILE PULLING INSIDE OF A PARKING LOT VEHICLE SURGED FORWARD. CONSUMER APPLIED THE BRAKES, AND THE VEHICLE CONTINUED TO SPEED, AND CRASHED INTO A BRICK WALL. UPON IMPACT, BOTH AIR BAGS DID NOT DEPLOY.

After making 90 rt. turn into parking space at idle speed with foot on brake, engine roared loudly and quickly accelerated the vehicle forward, jumping curb and crashing into cinderblock wall approx 15 ft. away where it came to a stop. Air bags deployed; driver turned off ignition.
