stand to help my daughter out of the road. Her knees was bleeding

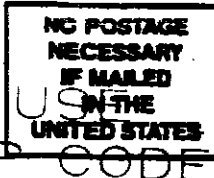
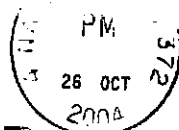
