UPON IMPACT, THE AIRBAG DID NOT DEPLOY. FIRESTONE, STEELTEX RADIAL, SIZE 285/75R16 DOT VDW81X12400. THE DRIVER AND WIFE BECAME UNCONSCIOUS AND WERE BOTH WERE TRANSPORTED BY AMBULANCE TO THE NEAREST HOSPITAL. *AK

IN 11-03 WHILE IN ARIZONA THE RIGHT REAR TIRE (SAME ORIGINAL TIRE AS ABOVE) DEVELOPED AN AIR BUBBLE UNDER THE TREAD AND HAD TO BE REPLACED. NO DAMAGE WAS DONE AT THAT TIME.
