Narrative Description of Incident(s), Failure(s), Crash(es), and Injury(ies).

On May 1, 2004 I was in a car accident in Crane, Virginia. A drunk driver ran the stop sign at a speed of 50mph in town. He hit me from the front side of my vehicle. My vehicle spinned around twice in the road. My vehicle was then headed up the road in the wrong direction. It was raining really hard at the time. The airbags didn't deploy. The motor in my vehicle was cracked and pushed back toward me. My vehicle was declared a total loss.

I was unable to attend work from May 2 to July 10 because of my injuries. I still have neck pain, leg pain, my left arm and lower back were sprained. My sister was a passenger in the vehicle at this time. She has since suffered from a bruised chest and breast. Both of her knees were bruised also. Neither the driver or the passenger airbags deploy.
