Narrative Description of Incident(s), Failure(s), Crash(es), and Injury(ies)

I Received by mail the recall notice for the Cam position Sensor. I had a check engine light warning in August and was advised by the Goodyear dealer that a cam position sensor was used and they replaced it. In Sept I received the recall notice. I took my Daewoo to the dealer and they said the cam sensor which I now had wasn't included in the campaign therefore the in-line fuse wasn't covered either. They then told me that my car was still at risk as a fire hazard even though the cam sensor wasn't originally defective. My position is that if my car is at risk as a fire hazard because of no in line fuse which is being replaced on other cars at no charge, then it should also be replaced on mine at no cost.

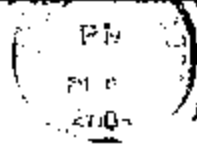
