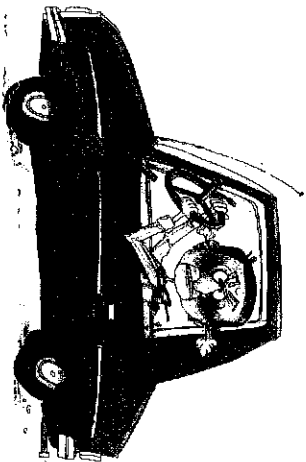

To Whom It May Concern:

This is in reference to an incident involving a '99 Honda Civic LX on July 28, 2004. This car was owned by me, [REDACTED]. The vehicle identification number is 2HGEJ6679XH [REDACTED]. The cause of the crash was a malfunction of the front airbags, not the side airbags. This car was not equipped with side airbags, it wasn't even a option. Anyway, sorry it took me so long to respond. I misplaced this. I found it in the process of moving. The deployment of the airbags knocked me unconscious. Causing me to loose control and hit the median. After coming to, the Mesa, Arizona Police gave me a ticket for failure to control vehicle. The car was totaled. I was not completely coherent after the accident. The Mesa Police left me there. I walked at least four miles, to the nearest facility that I could think of at the time. This place is called Natural Therapeutics. The owner is Rhonda Miranikis, L.M.T. I went to her massage school to learn therapeutic massage.

Please make note of the change on the airbags and that because of their malfunction, that the crash occurred.
