This was the 4th. time of occurrence, creating unsafe & dangerous situation due to sudden engine stop without warning. Situation has not occurred since part replacement. Owner has retained and has possession of replaced part.

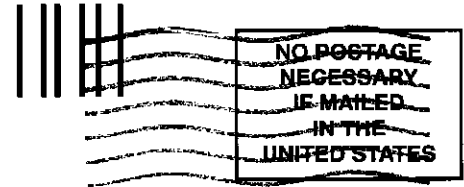

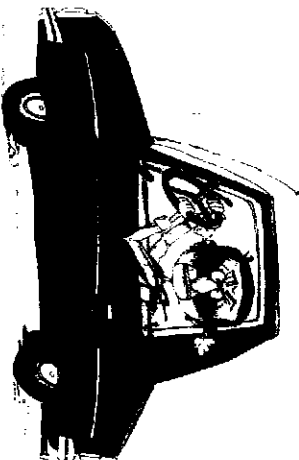
