TRADED IN A 2002 CAMRY (4 SPEED TRANE) NO DEFECTS OR PROBLEMS. WITH THE 5 SPEED TRANSMISSION (2005 CAMRY) RPM HAS INCREASED WHEN SLOWING DOWN TO 1100 RPM. EXCEPT FOR THIS ANOMALY, CAR IS EXCELLENT ALTHOUGH GAS CONSUMPTION HAS INCREASED. (29.5 MPG). THERE IS A POTENTIAL FOR AN ACCIDENT IN HEAVY SLOW TRAFFIC ESPECIALLY IN STOP AND GO SITUATION.
