In July of 1991 we received a safety recall notice (Campaign 86C16) in regards to our 1986 Pontiac Fiero. At that time the vehicle was not on the road. We registered the vehicle in August of 2004 - the first time since the recall notice.

I contacted our local dealer in regards to incorporating the recall, however, they said parts were no longer available. I then contacted Pontiac directly and was told the same thing...parts are no longer available...in effect, tough luck.

I am concerned since this recall stated "the parking brake system of these vehicles may contain a nonfunctional parking brake adjuster" "the parking brake system may not be able to hold the vehicle on a steep incline".

Do I have any recourse at this point? Thanks for your help.
