Jan. 29, 2005.

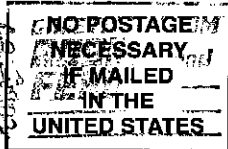

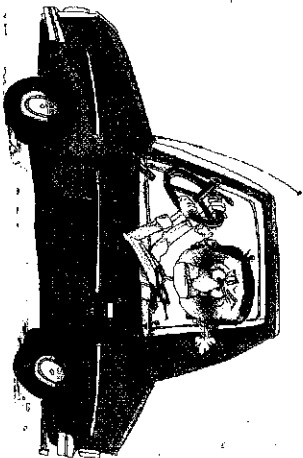
