WHEN TAKEN TO GET SERVICED THE PROBLEM COULD NOT BE DETERMINED. *AK while stopped the car will not accelerate for 5-7 seconds... the engine RPM does not increase even with the foot-pedal pushed to the floor... then the RPM does increase and car accelerates normally; and seems to operate normally until the next episode... I suspect a software problem related to the automatic version of the MINI-COOPER. THIS IS VERY DANGEROUS!
