The wires on top of the fuel sending unit go into molded plastic. The wires and plastic have separated. This causes the wires to contact, then no contact. This causes the fuse to blow. When you turn the key on it causes an arc + the fuse blows. When you replace the fuse, the same thing happens again. The fuel pump works fine, the sending unit is bad.
