Narrative Description of Incident(s), Failure(s), Crash(es), and Injury(ies)

ABS Brake started to pulsate and car would not stop "right away" at slow speeds (under 10 MPH). I brought the car to the dealer, explained the situation but it could not be replicated. I looked at the NHTS web site and found a recall for the EXACT same problem but the recall was only for CANADA - Corrosion on the ABS sensor would not allow car to stop "sometimes" at low (slow) speeds. After fighting with the dealer (Cupra Chevrolet in Scarsdale, N.Y. and bring it back a few times they acknowledged and fixed the problem. Thank you for all your good work!!

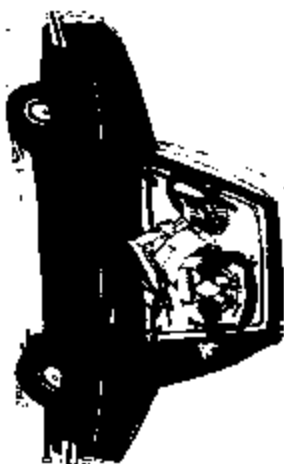
