DT: THE CONTACT HAD A RECALL ON THE VEHICLE FOR THE SEAT ADJUSTMENT. THE CONTACT TOOK THE VEHICLE TO THE DEALER, AND THEY HAD HIS MOTHER SIT IN THE SEAT. THEY ADJUSTED THE SEAT FOR HIS MOTHER AND THE SEAT WILL NOT MOVE, NOW IT IS STUCK IN THAT ONE SPOT AND YOU CANNOT ADJUST THE SEAT TO GO ANY FARTHER BACK. THE PROBLEM WITH THE SEAT TO MAKE THEM DO THE RECALL WAS THAT THE SEAT WOULD SLOWLY MOVE BACKWARD WHILE SITTING IN IT. THE DEALER SAID THAT WAS THE BEST THAT THEY COULD DO. THE CONTACT WAS IN AN ACCIDENT BECAUSE HE COULD NOT MANUEVER GOOD ENOUGH TO CONTROL THE STEERING WHEEL AND IT CAUSED AN ACCIDENT. *AK
