Thank you for your correspondence dated May 6, 2005, requesting a formal investigation to determine the accuracy of the EDR/SDM if modifications are made to a motor vehicle. Your correspondence was received on May 16, 2005.

Regrettably, your correspondence requesting a formal investigation does not meet the eligibility requirements established by the United States Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) to be considered as a petition for a safety defect investigation. If you wish to pursue this matter further, you can petition the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration to conduct a safety defect investigation in accordance with Title 49 CFR Part 552, Petitions for Rulemaking, Defect, and Noncompliance Orders. We have enclosed a copy of Title 49 CFR Part 552 for your information. In order for your petition to meet all eligibility requirements, please pay particular attention to Title 49 CFR Parts 552.1 through 552.10.
