They replaced the entire sun roof but car paint was scratched everywhere. I am still finding bits of glass.

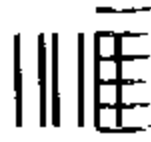

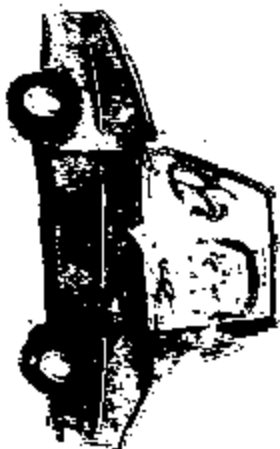
