RE: May 16, 2005 Letter Regarding Denial of Status in the GM Class Action Settlement

To Whom It May Concern:

I am in receipt of your May 16th letter wherein you indicate that the VIN for our 1978 Chevrolet C20 ¾ ton truck is in consistent with GM's qualifying full size pickups or chassis cab models as of July 4, 1996.

I previously forwarded the VIN for our 1978 Chevrolet C20 ¾ ton truck. Your letter of May 16th indicated that the VIN does not match your list of qualifying vehicles and excludes us from status in the settlement class.

Your records are incorrect. The VIN I previously forwarded to you was CC8248J168923. Apparently you felt that the information I sent was incorrect or capriciously decided to exclude my husband and me from the GM Settlement.

In order to better satisfy your requirements to be included in the GM Class Action Settlement I have enclosed a copy of the State of Montana Certificate of Title for the vehicle in question and a copy of our Certificate of Liability Insurance – State of Montana from Farmers Insurance.

I hope that these legal records are sufficient to satisfy your need for proof that my husband and I do own a GM vehicle that does qualify in the GM Class Action Settlement.

Thank you for your correspondence concerning the GM Class Action Settlement.

The approved class action settlement defines class members as persons who owned the following qualifying full size pickups or chassis cab models on July 4, 1996:

These are the only vehicles included in the class action lawsuit. Unfortunately, based on the vehicle identification number (VIN), the documentation you submitted was for an automobile or truck model not listed above and is, therefore, not included in the settlement class.

It is possible that the VIN on your title and/or registration is incorrect. To verify this, please compare the VIN on your title with the VIN on the vehicle. The VIN is visible through the lower corner driver's side of the windshield on newer trucks and is mounted on the engine side of the firewall on the older trucks. If the VINs are identical, the vehicle is not included in the settlement class. If they are different, please write us explaining the differences in the VIN on the paperwork versus the plate on the vehicle and we will be pleased to recheck your vehicle's eligibility.
