The first time this happened I was going less than 5 MPH and almost hit a child in a crosswalk. GM is aware of the problem in the northern states, it is caused by corrosion by winter road salt. GM already recalled the vehicles in Canada. GM thinks it is not a big enough problem in the U.S. to issue a recall. I hope you can do something to get these unsafe vehicles off the highway before someone gets hurt bad.
