LOOKING OUT DRIVER WINDOW AT SIDE MIRROR. THE SIDE VENTS REFLECT IN THE WINDOW RIGHT IN THE AREA OF THE SIDE MIRROR. IT GIVES THE APPEARANCE OF LOOKING THRU A VENEETUAL BLIND WHEN TRYING TO SEE ONCOMING TRAFFIC.

AT NIGHT THE INSTRUMENT PANEL IS VERY BRIGHTLY REFLECTED IN THE WINDOW. WHEN YOU LOOK AT ONCOMING TRAFFIC IN THE SIDE MIRROR YOU ARE DISTRACTED BY THIS VERY BRIGHT REFLECTION. I HAVE TRIED DIMMING THE INSTRUMENT PANEL, BUT IT DOESN'T HELP TOO MUCH.

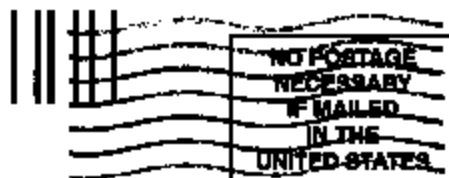
