We own a 2003 Harley Davidson FLHTCUI. Prior to having the recall performed on 5/04/04 (18,690 miles driven) we had no problems with stalling and loss of all power. Since having the recall performed and to this date (now at 46,351 miles) we are still experiencing stalling and loss of all power which is an extreme safety hazard. We have made numerous attempts to have the Harley Davidson dealer rectify the issue with no satisfaction. The last time we left the motorcycle at the dealership from June 16th ending July 7th. They returned it to us without regard for our safety saying they could not duplicate the problem.
