DT: CONTACT STATES SHE BOUGHT A 2005 NISSAN MAXIM 3.5 SL ON NOVEMBER 15, 04. TOWARDS THE END OF MAY, SHE TOOK IT IN FOR A ROUTINE SERVICE AND SHE LODGED HER FIRST COMPLAINT THEN BECAUSE BY THE 25TH OF MAY, THE CAR WAS EXPERIENCING ACCELERATION PROBLEMS. WHEN SHE IS STOPPED AT A STOP LIGHT AND SHE PUTS HER FOOT ON THE ACCELERATOR IT WILL COAST INTO EIGHT LANES OF TRAFFIC, IT WILL LURCH OR JUMP AND THEN IT WILL START TO RUN NORMALLY. THERE IS A SUBSTANTIAL AMOUNT OF TIME THAT PASSES BEFORE THE CAR WILL RUN NORMALLY. THIS HAPPENED SEVEN TIMES BY THE 25TH OF MAY. IT OCCURS RANDOMLY. ONCE IT HAPPENED THREE TIMES WITHIN ONE HALF HOUR. APPROX. 4 WEEKS AGO THE DEALER CALLED HER AND TOLD HER A TROUBLESHOOTER WOULD MEET HER HALF-WAY OR AT HER HOUSE OR AT THE DEALERSHIP AND SHE TURNED HIM DOWN BECAUSE SHE WAS AFRAID TO DRIVE THE CAR. SHE SAYS THIS IS WHEN THE DEALER STOPPED TALKING TO HER. NOW SHE IS TRYING TO GET THE LEMON LAW ENFORCED AND SOMEONE IS SUPPOSE TO CALL HER WHEN THE APPOINTMENT IS SET TO COME OUT AND INVESTIGATE THE PROBLEM. THE CONSUMER IS TO DRIVE THE CAR WHILE THEY INVESTIGATE IT WITH SOME SOPHISTICATED MACHINERY. THE CONSUMER STATES THAT ON MAY 25, 2005 THE CAR HAD ONLY 5542 MILES ON IT.
