A safety complaint form VOQ received 9-09-05 of which I received typed on 9-20-05. Verification of form information was mailed 10-22-05 accompanied with a letter for which entailed this vehicle's history and other facts.

I am contacting you due to the above initial problem has continued to needing further work done. I continue to complain that this vehicle by rights is still under the RECALL by manufacturer notice you had listed.

Enclosed is a copy of proof for the Recall continued replacement on transmission system parts of coolant lines as of 12-14-05. I have the old GM original of two replacement parts. This repair helped with having seemed to stopping signs of vehicle wanting to overheat until presently. This is proof my vehicle is in need of this Recall and reimbursement issuance. The transmission system coolant areas are still showing leakage. It seems a chain reaction to other areas have occurred from the trans coolant system to replacement done for other coolant areas that have been fixed for reassurance (this includes several sensors, other hoses, more analysis', other parts, etc.). There are codes showing up indicating need of further transmission work. And yes this vehicle is adding up miles.

Has an investigation been put into action for this matter? I have not received any further correspondence to the problem.

Has there been a contact to or through you from General Motors? Because I have not received any further contact from them either.

Will there be a Recall issued for this vehicle? Presently NO RECALL notification(s) to being received.
