DT: THE ANTI-LOCK BRAKES PULSATED AT LOW SPEEDS. COULD FEEL IT IN THE PEDAL, AND COULD SLIGHTLY HEAR IT KICK IN. IT DID THIS ON DRY ROADS. NHTSA RECALL 05V279000 WAS ISSUED IN AUGUST 2005. BUT THIS VEHICLE WAS NOT INCLUDED IN THE RECALL DUE TO VIN. WENT TO THE DEALER AND BASICALLY SAID YOU HAVE TO NOVEMBER. STARTED NOTICING THIS AROUND JULY 15, 2005, AND IT DID THIS OCCASIONALLY. *AK Gmc Dealer stated the anti lock brake recall is not official till November 2005; but dealer does not know if my vehicle will be included (a campaign number has been issued). Internet research show a similar anti lock brake recall was done in Canada.
