The SRS light continues to remain on. This indicates the air bags are malfunctioning.

2003: The local Honda Service manager said that Honda may recall this years Accord because they have had problems and the 1995's were recalled for electrical problem.

• Fall of 2003: After another visit to local Honda I called American Honda Customer Service. They also said that they advised me to wait for the recall.

• 2003-present: I made several contacts with local Honda and American Honda in the summer of 2005. Both stated that there probably be no recall because of the length of time. Local Honda said it would cost \$95 to diagnose it. American Honda said The local dealer sets the rate but there is a 50% chance that American Honda would pay for the cost of the repairs.

In my opinion Honda shd pay the cost of the diagnosis as well as a portion of the repairs if it is a manufacturing defect.
