Reference: Condition of 1998 Jaguar XJ8

This is to advise you that subject car's engine haphazardly shuts off when on the road. This is extremely dangerous mainly on high speed highways cars and heavy trucks, unable to stop, almost immediately eat or up with a possibility of a high speed rear end collision. It is frightening to have a truck and trailer bearing down at you at 65 to 75 miles per hour. I have avoided such collision but it was so frightening to my wife that she refuses to drive it.

The fault first appeared while under warranty, i.e. within a year of purchase from Palmetto Jaguar of Charleston, S.C. They were unable to repair the car. Fortunately

it ceased occurring and didn't start it up until a month or two ago. Actually I took it to the dealer several times in that year or so, but obtained no results from them. They were at a loss on how to repair it.

I repeat it can be deadly if this occurs on a highway as there would be great damage and possibly loss of life. Incurring legal action on our part
