Dear Sirs/Madams

This letter is to inform your agency of a serious safety defect in my GMC Envoy. The details concerning the defect are noted in the enclosed repair invoice.

The defect involved a malfunction of a power train control module which resulted in my truck's failure to accelerate when attempting to move across a median ahead of oncoming traffic. An oncoming vehicle was barely able to swerve around my vehicle which had virtually come to a stand still in the oncoming lane. The oncoming driver's quick reaction and his ability to swerve into an available open lane avoided what could have been a serious collision resulting in injury or death.

I trust this failure of a power train control module will be investigated to determine whether similar defects exist in other vehicles which would justify a recall and remedy campaign.
