DT: THE CONTACT STATED THE ELECTRONIC THROTTLE MODULE (ETM) FAILED. THE ENGINE IDLE DROPPED, AND SURGED UPON STARTING THE VEHICLE. WHILE DRIVING THE VEHICLE IT SURGED AND THEN LOST POWER. THE VEHICLE STALLED WHILE AT A STOP LIGHT AND WOULD NOT IMMEDIATELY START BACK. THE VEHICLE STARTED AGAIN AFTER THE FOURTH ATTEMPT. THE ETM WAS REPLACED APPROXIMATELY A YEAR AGO, BUT NOW THE VEHICLE EXPERIENCED THE SAME PROBLEMS AGAIN. *AK

Throttle body replaced initially on 5/25/04. 3/29/05 began experiencing some stalling, surging and loss of power. Took car in to dealer + mass air flow meter was replaced at cost of 380.23. After repair problems continued on 3/29/05 took car back to dealer, dealer stated unable to find any problems. Between dates of 3/29 and 11/29 car really undesirable multiple stalls + surging. Throttle body replaced 2nd time on 11/29/05.
