THE DEALER PERFORMED NUMEROUS REPAIRS, AND COULD NOT OFFER AN EXPLANATION AS TO WHY THESE PROBLEMS OCCURRED AT SUCH LOW MILEAGE. THE VEHICLE IS CURRENTLY AT THE DEALER AWAITING REPAIRS ON THE REAR WINDSHIELD WIPER. *AK
