I ran out of gas and had to walk for 1 mile. I am unable to regulate my speed. I have owned 6 vehicles and not one of them had problems with a speedometer. When the dealership admits that this is a common problem and Auto Zone said they have people with the same problem frequently. I feel this should be a recall. The speedometer fluctuates and you can't tell when it correct or if it is incorrect. If judging your speed on a turn it is likely to cause an accident.

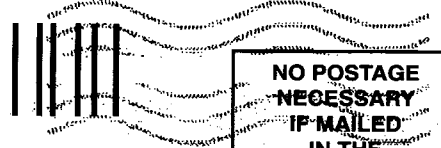

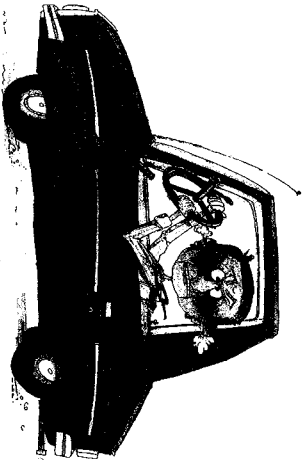
