Reporting vehicle problems have never been at the top of my list, however I know it is important with safety and design of the automobiles.

My car is a 1998 Toyota, Corolla with 91,474 easy miles on it. Listed are the problems I have had with it and the cost was plenty to either repair or replace with White River Toyota, in White River Jct., VT 05001

At 60,000 miles the driver's side seatbelt failed at the latch area where it hooks in. At 86,000 miles the trunk lock broke inside the cylinder. Also, at the same time the driver's door handle broke inside, so I had to crawl out the passenger side to get out. Now, at 91,000 miles the seat belt light in the dash stays on all the time, just a blinking away, even when everyone has a seat belt on. I refuse to get this fixed, enough already!
