I am writing to express my concern and disappointment for the set of Goodyear tires that came on my 2003 Oldsmobile Silhouette.

(only 29580 miles, P225/60R16, TPC SPEC 1089MS, E13-0294149)

Without warning, my family and I came close to a serious and possibly fatal accident because of your tires, as I was on the Florida turnpike only minutes before pulling into a parking lot when a tire went flat. It happened that the steel was broken, and broken through the rubber, in a complete circle around the tire, near where the tread meets the sidewall on both front tires. The rear tires were only slightly better.

After nearly one hundred years of investigation and engineering, it is almost beyond belief that Goodyear and Oldsmobile have teamed up in such a disastrous, and and unsafe manner. Especially after many similar historical precedents.
