IN ORDER FOR THE WINDSHIELD WIPERS TO WORK, ALL OF THE ABOVE FUNCTIONS HAVE TO BE PERFORMED. ONCE THE WINDSHIELD WIPERS START WORKING, THEY ONLY WORK FOR A SHORT PERIOD OF TIME. THERE IS AN NHTSA RECALL, # 87V017000, REGARDING THE WINDSHIELD WIPER WASHER; SWITCH; WIRING. THE VEHICLE HAS THE SAME PROBLEMS AS INDICATED IN THE RECALL; HOWEVER IT IS NOT INCLUDED IN THE RECALL DUE TO THE VIN.
