TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

I am writing to you regarding an accident that I was involved in on 4-1-06, which I sustained head injuries from. As a result, I am asking for damages in the amount of \$25,000.00. The reason I am asking this amount is because I believe that the severity of these injuries could have been prevented if the air bag would have deployed. I do understand that air bags do not prevent injuries in a collision; but as stated in owner's handbook, "The air bags supplement the protection provided by safety belts. Air bags distribute the force of the impact more evenly over the occupant's upper body, stopping the occupant more gradually." I never received any recall notice that this make/model had any safety defect (air bags) so I am assuming that the reason the air bag did not deploy was the fault of the Saturn Corporation.

Again, I am asking for damages in the amount of \$25,000.00 for the following reasons: Hospital expenses, head injuries and lacerations, loss of work and wages, and mental anguish, such as being transported to Celebration Hospital, FL. by ambulance, once at the hospital multiple xrays had to be taken, plus a CAT scan had to be performed. I am willing to negotiate any counter offer the Saturn Corporation may offer. I would appreciate hearing from you as soon as possible so I don't have to institute any legal action.

I am enclosing copies of State Farm's adjuster report, accident report, and hospital bill. If there is any further information you need, please let me know.
