He told me to take truck back to Horner.

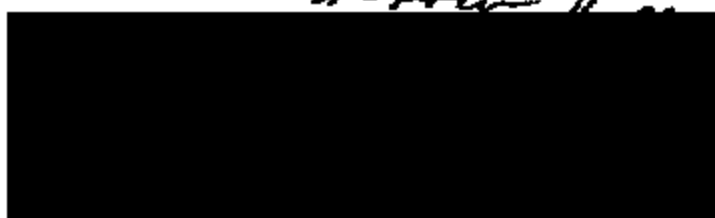
A factory rep was to go there on Thursday Jan 8 and ~~not~~ would call me. He did not call and had not been there at 9:30 AM, when I was there.
