twenty years old with two sons who were little boys about two and four years old. I ended up losing the car. I later purchased a red Chevy Cavalier, in which I payed \$850 from a school teach in Pasadena, I parked the car in front and on the side of my apartment but, the car continued to collect parking tickets, it finally was impounded by the Pasadena Police Department, and the license plate was also stolen, and I reported to D.M.V. and they replaced it. IN November 2003 I purchase a Ford Aerostar Van for picking up my children and for the grocery store, because I suffer from back problems, that I believe was caused by abuse. Somebody ran a stop sign on Altadena Dr. and crashed into my van, and their license plate fell off their car. I recently junked the van with Pick-A-Part.

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I have been a careful driver
sense I was a young teen, my
mother taught me how to drive, I
am the only girl in my family
that drive, in the State of California
I am now forty-years old, and
I became homeless in August
2003, I had to move in a Shelter
with my two sons, but the Welfare
Office suggested that we go to
a motel we were also living in
our van some nights when we
didn't have money, but my sons
began to work and buy food for
themselves. I have spent lots
of money, me and my sons to
buy tires, I also had the trans-
mission repaired, which cost \$1800
dollars, Pasadena has some horrible
drivers who continue to drive wreck-
less, and injured many people. I
couldn't understand why I was
always in court, when I do not

drive under the influence. I do not want to drive anymore because I have had my drivers license for over 10 years, and it has never been suspended, I just renewed my drivers license, and it doesn't expire until the year 2010. My son who is now nineteen years old who is trying to drive it is frightening for me as an accident victim because I was injured as a passenger, so I was not planning to drive anymore, but my son has purchased this Chevy Camaro with license plate no. 2MTK021 & the I.D. is 161AP87H6DN146334, I am not happy with this purchase because he has no license, only his permit, I have to drive him to work and to the market. I have written to the DMV because the seller has not turned over the bill of sale, he does not have a drivers license at all. Please write me H
