I am writing to make a record of my dissatisfaction with your companies to make record should it be necessary to file a law suit for failing to inform me when a vehicle that I bought from your company through Gary Barbera's Chryslerland was recalled.

On December 26, 2000 I purchased a new 2000 Chrysler Cirrus LX from Gary Barbera's Chryslerland. On April 2, 2006, the vehicle was totaled as a result of an internal fire. While my family was stressed with this dilemma, I was informed by a friend that this particular type of car has been recalled effective January 5, 2006 for problem associated with high pressure steering hose that may crack and develop a power steering fluid that results in an under-hood fire.

On May 1, 2006, I received an undated letter (post marked 4/27/06) from Customer Services Operations, DaimlerChrysler Corporation informing me that this particular type of Chrysler has been recalled ("safety recall E23") for High Pressure Power steering hose, the very problem my vehicle had that resulted to it been burnt.

I consulted the Gary Barbera's Chryslerland for advice and they told me that they have nothing to do with the problem. Instead, they referred me to you (Daimler Chrysler Corporation) for redress.

I wish to inform you that my family was pressured to purchase a new vehicle. The losses that I have incurred as a direct result of the problem are now in the thousands in terms of dollars. In view of this, I am requesting an immediate meeting with your management to discuss my losses for compensation. Please note that anything contrary will leave me with no option but to file a law suit against your corporation for damage.
