**If the microwave in your RV is not affected by this recall (see attached to determine such) OR;
if the microwave has already been serviced for the recall (see attached to determine such)**

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Highway Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Samsung Electronics Co., Ltd. has decided that a defect exists which relates to motor vehicle safety in microwave models installed in certain RVs manufactured during the period of May, 2000 to September, 2003.

The defect can cause the Microwave Oven to start by itself without user intervention. If this should occur when food or other material is left inside the oven cavity and the oven goes into an auto start mode, a potential safety condition exists which may cause smoke or further damage. To avoid this occurrence the unit should be unplugged or the door left open.

If you have not yet obtained service to your microwave, we ask that you do so as soon as possible to correct the condition without delay. The service and required parts are provided on-site and free of charge. If you have sustained any damage related to this defect, you may be eligible for reimbursement and should contact us at the Samsung customer service number indicated below.
